## TUITION & FEE PAYMENT

- Application fee is due at time of submitting Application for Enrollment and is not refundable. Application fee will be deducted from Registration Fee upon enrollment.
- Annual tuition is divided into ten equal payments. Payment #1 is the Security Deposit, due at the time of enrollment. Payments #2-10 are billed on the fifteenth of each month (August – April) with payment due within 30 days from date of invoice. On May 15 you will be invoiced the final tuition amount and at that time you will be credited the Security Deposit
- Students that enroll after the first day of school will have their tuition prorated for the remaining school days to determine the total tuition. That tuition will be divided as follows: Payment #1 is the Security Deposit, equal to one monthly tuition. Payments #2 will be a prorated monthly tuition. Payments #3 and all following will be at the monthly tuition rate.
- If enrollment stops prior to the end of the school year, the Security Deposit is not refundable.
- Registration Fee secures a place for your child and is not refundable.
- Materials Fee is invoiced during the first regular billing cycle (August 15) and helps cover cost of supplemental supplies and Montessori materials in each classroom (plus annual camp trip for Middle School).
- Additional charges (hot lunch, after-school programs, etc.) are compiled monthly and added to your tuition bill .
- Tuition continues during student absences.
- Account balances which are unpaid after 30 days will be charged a late fee assessed as follows:
  - Account balance past due amount \$1.00 - \$100.00 is \$25.00 per month
  - Account balance past due amount \$101.00 - \$1,000.00 is \$50.00 per month
  - Account balance past due amount \$1,001.00 and higher is \$100.00 per month
- Limited scholarships or multiple child discounts are available and must be applied for & renewed annually.
